2007 Rules & Regulations

1. All entries must be received no later than 4:00 on July 2, 2007. (The fax machine will be turned off at this time!) Changes on show day will be subject to surcharge AND we will **not** be able to guarantee you a block or position.
2. Springboard Chop entries **must** indicate whether they cut Right or Left on their entry form. We have 6 springboard trees. If we designate the trees for R or L we can run up to 18 cutters without interference of board holes.
3. Contestants' meeting at 9:00 a.m. on show day. Eliminations and preliminaries will follow.
4. ALL axe heads must be pinned, including throwing axes.
5. Safety pants or chaps for all chainsaw events are mandatory.
6. Contestants may not enter a division lower than their current rating.
7. Intermediate Single Buck is Peg & Raker factory standard saws only.
8. Crosscut wood will be white pine; chopping wood will be aspen/poplar.
9. To qualify for axe throw, contestants must enter at least two other events.
10. There will be a free breakfast for competitors from 7 to 8:30 a.m.
11. CANLOG rules apply and decisions of contest judges will be final.
12. Power saws will not be run during the show, except during stated competitions.
13. Only ONE contestant per entry form, i.e., each partner in a Jack & Jill requires a separate form.
