Powell River Logger Sports SHOW RULES

1. All entries must be in by June 24th. Stated entry fee's will double per event for entry's received after June 24th. Entries received after June 24th may be rejected and blocks may not be available.
2. All events will run on Saturday to Sunday. Registration will open at 8:30 am. Competitors meeting starts at 9 am. Eliminations will start after competitors meeting. Saturday's show will begin at 12 pm and Sunday's show will begin at 11 am.
3. Canlog Rules Apply.
4. Contestants may enter only one class in the same event and may not enter a division lower than their current rating in any event.
5. To qualify for Axe Throw event, the contestant must enter at least one other event. All Axes must be pinned.
6. Canlog membership is mandatory for all contestants over and is available at www.canlog.com. If you already have insurance please mark your number on the entry form.
7. Cross-cut sawing: Traditional Peg n' Rakers are the only allowed saw in Novice, either M-tooth or Traditional Peg n' Raker may be used in Intermediate, and no restriction to saw types in Open/Ladies class.
8. To assist with equipment scheduling conflicts please advise prior to June 28th if sharing equipment. Heats will not be changed at time of event due to equipment sharing.
9. Power Saw Races – 100CC, speed bucking (2) cuts must be down- up, Total amount of wood cut must not take more than 4 inches. No marking of wood on PNE cut. Depending on amount of entries some power saw races may be run in prelims and times will count for standings.
10. Unlimited Hot Saw - 2 cuts must be down-up. Total amount of wood cut must not be over 4 inches. Can mark wood
11. ABSOLUTELY NO WHINING – everyone must have fun!
12. Intermediate 2 Board Springboard – will be limited to 12 entries. Winner of last years contest receives a guaranteed entry, which leaves 11 up for grabs on a first come first serve basis. Entry form must be submitted and entry fee's paid.
13. All chopping wood will be Red Alder, all power saw wood will be Douglas Fir, all hand saw wood will be White Pine.
14. Peter Colliver Memorial Masters Chop will be 11" Alder Underhand Chop. 50 Years or Older
15. Powell River Logger Sports Association reserves the right to cancel any event if there are fewer than 6 entrants.
16. When whistle sounds in infield only competitors can remain in the infield. Anyone else in the infield will be excused from the show.
17. Novice and Open Tree Climb competitors will be expected to climb twice, once on each pole. Combined times will stand for placement. Open climbers will climb once Saturday and once Sunday
