

### The Canadian Loggers Sports Association Code of Conduct

1. All competitors must have a paid CANLOG Membership before competing.
2. All competitors and show officials must know and understand the rules and regulations of the Canadian Loggers Sports Association.
3. All competitors are expected to behave in a sportsmanlike manner conduct with all when speaking with CANLOG officials, show officials, volunteers, spectators and fellow competitors. Any unsportsmanlike conduct such as swearing, yelling, throwing of equipment, and/or using obscene gestures will not be tolerated.
4. All competitors are expected to behave and compete in a safe manner and are not to encourage any behaviours or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of their fellow competitors.
5. Disciplinary action for unsafe or unsportsmanlike conduct as deemed so by the majority of the Executive:

1st Infraction - Letter of Apology sent to all parties concerned

2<sup>nd</sup> Infraction - Immediate suspension for remainder of season and the next season plus a letter of apology

3<sup>rd</sup> Infraction - Lifetime ban from all CANLOG sanctioned competitions
