# Show Rules

- All entries forms and fees must be received no later than **6:00 pm on April 16, 2023**.
- **Registration will happen two weeks prior to the show via email.** We will send an email to the address you provide to confirm events. The booth will be open from 8:00am to 9:00am on Saturday May 27<sup>th</sup> for those we weren't able to connect with.
- We hope to minimize changes to entry form and partners on the day of the show – please contact us prior if you know of changes.
- Contestants' meeting will be **May 27<sup>th</sup>, Saturday morning at 9:00 a.m.** followed by eliminations for Axe Throw and Stock Saw. The main show will run from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- CANLOG rules will be followed in all events.
- To qualify for axe throw, contestants must enter at least one other event.
- Top four in Axe Throw and Stock Saw will move on to the Main Show. All 4 finalists will throw at once. If sharing an axe with another finalist a show axe will be provided.
- Unlimited Hot Saw will be a maximum of 12 competitors. Event will follow Stihl Timbersports rules.
- Ladies Single Buck – Open Division 2 is a NON-CANLOG event available to competitors that have not previously won a single buck event.
- Power saws will not be run during the show, except during stated events and warm period prior to the start of the show.
- **Safety pants or chaps, hearing and eye protection** for all chainsaw events are **mandatory**.
- The decision of the competition judges will be final in any and all matters pertaining to the contestants and the show rules.
- If equipment is being shared between competitors in the same event please indicate on your entry form (remember all 4 axe throw finalists are throwing at the same time).
- **\*\*\*NEW\*\*\* - Ladies Standing & Novice Springboard Competitors:** *to maintain safety standards and improve spectator engagement during the show, the Port McNeill Loggersports Society requests that competency be demonstrated prior to competing during the show. Please supply name of experienced competitor to validate your competency or forward a video of yourself completing the event. If any individual does not receive spot in the show during the competition (you will be notified prior to the show and decision discussed) a free training session will be provided before or after the show (your choice to match travel schedule) to assist your development.*

## Novice/Local Events

- Traditional saw will be supplied if needed for the Novice Double Buck.
- Safety equipment must be worn – caulk boots/shoes, safety chaps/pants, eye and hearing protection. All safety gear will be available, only exception is caulk boots or shoes. Throwing axes will be available also.
- Novice competitors must wear chopping guards.
- The top overall novices will choose from an equipment prize table based on prize points awarded by each event
- No entry fee for novice/local events. Canlog membership or day pass is required.
